The majority of the Romanian puppies arrive with us at the age of 16 weeks or above. Most haven't had the same help as other puppies and lack social skills and they do best with a calm gentle dog to guide them.

Some are more outward going and have been handled better by the public or rescuers and could, in the right circumstances be the only dog in the home, but ALL of them need extra help and aren't the same as getting a normal 8 week puppy.

This is why we ask for previous experience/knowledge of dogs and look for adopters who have had a dog before, as on the whole, they are not suitable as a family's first pet.

HOWEVER these are incredibly sweet dogs and with time and patience they make the most wonderful friends. They will give you that little bit extra back because you have put that in that extra bit into helping them.
